Project Overview:Building Renovations

Scope of Project

The Amazing Things Happen Here campaign's purpose is to raise funds for the renovation of facilities at Madisonville First United Methodist Church. This renovation will focus on the Education Building, built in 1965. The Trustees recognized that the 1965 building is in need of significant updating to meet the church's current and future needs. The renovation plans call for a total renovation of the entire Education Building including the downstairs classrooms, the upstairs classrooms, the Fireside Room and the Children's Church Room. In addition to the Education Building, the scope of the project also includes flooring for other areas of the main floor of the building. Important ministries of the church take place in these areas, including the church nursery, preschool, children's ministry, Adult Sunday School and other discipleship classes, the administrative work of the church, and a variety of community and outreach ministries. Our church stands at the center of our community, and we recognize an investment in our space to be an investment in our community, in our future, and in the Kingdom of God.

Main Floor: Preschool & Children's Areas

PRESCHOOL & CHILDREN'S HALLWAY

The first floor of the Education Building houses nine rooms that serve as the church's preschool, with some rooms doubling for service as the church nursery and children's Sunday School classrooms. Renovations included in the scope of this plan have already begun – the restrooms were fully renovated in 2022 and new ceilings, lighting, electrical work, flooring, and paint gave a new look in summer 2023. Remaining work to be done includes signage & art (in progress) and new furnishings, cabinetry, technology & doors.

Work Already Completed or Begun: \$345,000 Remaining Work: \$95,000



A new children's check-in station would be installed to facilitate a higher level of security and peace-of-mind for our children's ministry families and highlight our commitment to safeguarding children.

Cost: \$14,000

Main Floor: Lobby, Offices & Fireside Room

MAIN LOBBY & OFFICES

The main lobby area, from the glass security doors to the Sanctuary, will receive updated LVT flooring to replace worn carpeting and match the flooring already installed down the preschool hallway. New flooring will extend into the eight adjacent offices, in many cases replacing worn carpeting. The two staircases adjacent to these areas will also receive updated treading to enhance safety and to match the new flooring.

Cost \$101,000

FIRESIDE ROOM

The fireside room will be renovated with new flooring, lighting, ceilings, paint, furnishings, and cabinetry. The renovations will help to restore a welcoming, semi-formal space, along with providing flexibility for a variety of church and community meetings and events. The kitchenette space will also be updated to meet current needs for hosting events.

Cost \$105,000

Main Floor: Gym & Conference Rooms


GYM CONFERENCE ROOMS

Worn and damaged carpeting around the perimeter of the gym will be replaced with quality LVT flooring to provide a cleaner, more welcoming look.

CONFERENCE ROOMS

New LVT flooring will also replace worn and damaged carpeting in the Conference Rooms, Mission Room, and adjacent office. A designated gift will see flooring replaced in the Conference Rooms in April 2024.

Cost \$50,000

Second Floor: Restrooms

SECOND FLOOR RESTROOMS

The outdated men's and women's restrooms located on the second floor education building hallway will be refreshed with new flooring, ceiling, lighting, and fixtures; similar to the restroom renovations completed on the first floor of the Education Building.

Cost: \$75,000

Adult Classrooms & Second Floor Hallway

ADULT CLASSROOMS

The nine adult classroom spaces on the second floor of the Education Building will receive major updates including new flooring, paint, ceilings, lighting, furnishings, window shades, cabinetry and technology. These classrooms provide a home for Adult Sunday School classes and Wednesday Night Alive studies and groups, and will be well equipped to host life-changing moments for years to come.

HALLWAY & RESTROOMS

The tired-looking second floor hallway of the Education Building will be transformed with new flooring, paint, ceilings, lighting, and signage.

Cost for Classrooms, Hallway & Restrooms: \$575,000

Children's Church Room & Upstairs Children's Classrooms

CHILDREN'S CLASSROOMS

The two upstairs Children's Classrooms for second through fifth grades will receive major updates including new flooring, paint, ceilings, lighting, furnishings, window shades, cabinetry and technology. These spaces will be equipped to welcome and teach children the Bible and lead them into relationship with Jesus for generations to come.

Cost: \$45,000

CHILDREN'S CHURCH (ROOM 222)

The large upstairs children's area used for Sunday children's church and Wednesday Night Alive activities, will receive major updates. The fresh new look will include new paint, flooring, artwork, window treatments, and furnishings. The room will also be modified to include a small stage area and updated technology including a sound and presentation system.

Cost: \$105,000

Creative Strategies For Giving

HOW CAN I GIVE?

Cash or check can be given, marked "Capital Campaign", in the offering plate or basket, through mail addressed to the church, or in one of the secure drop-boxes located at the church.

Monetary gifts can also be given online at m1umc.org/give via card or bank draft. Reoccurring bank draft gifts can be set up in the Finance Office or using the form available.

WHAT ABOUT GIFTS OTHER THAN CASH?

Gifts other than cash include stocks, bonds, annuities, property, and other assets.

WHAT ASSETS COULD I GIVE?

Appreciated assets held more than one year, such as publicly traded stocks, mutual funds, bonds, real estate, and other readily marketable property often provide tax advantages.

WHY CONTRIBUTE GIFTS OTHER THAN CASH?

The tax code is very generous toward this form of giving. Giving the asset directly to the church allows the church to sell the asset, thereby eliminating potential capital gains tax to the donor. This also results in a larger gift to the church.

HOW DOES THE TAX BENEFIT WORK?

Itemized deduction: The donor is allowed to include 100% of the market value of many of these assets as charitable contributions for tax purposes, if held more than one year. Because of its tax exempt status, the church will receive the full market value, less transaction costs, as the time of the sale without paying capital gains taxes.

TAX INCENTIVES

There may be tax-free incentives for IRA holders who give from their IRA, consult your tax advisor for more information.

Creative Strategies For Giving

CASH FLOW GIFTS

Smaller gifts add up! By giving smaller amounts at higher frequencies – weekly, semi-monthly or monthly – large gifts can be reached in smaller steps. Using electronic fund transfers can be beneficial when making these gifts.

DIVERTED FUNDS GIFTS

Freeing up funds that are currently going to other areas of spending allows a person to increase giving to God's work. Diverting funds from entertainment, dining out, dues, subscriptions, gifts, allowances, or transportation offers lifestyle adjustments that impact one's giving.

DELAYED EXPENDITURES

Postponing major expenditures such as automobiles, home projects, or trips provides substantial giving opportunities.

INCOME PRODUCING ASSETS

Dividend income, interest income, payments from rental properties, or income from other assets provide a source for increased giving.

SALE OF ASSETS

Sale of major assets, such as house, car, land, or business provides available income for giving.

FREEDOM FROM DEBT

Looking ahead to the next three years, you may discover that debt obligations will be fulfilled. This frees up revenue for additional giving.

RAISES AND BONUSES

Contributing raises and bonuses are also creative methods that can be used to increase giving.

UNIQUE SKILLS INCOME

Some people have marketable hobbies or skills that enable them to give from those new profits.

CORPORATE GIFTS

Business owners may be able to provide gifts-in-kind that result in a stronger gift to the church and tax benefits to the donor.

CHARITABLE GIVING RESOURCES

Reviewing all charitable donations in light of their impact on the Kingdom of God affords a potential resource for significant giving.

SAVINGS AND ANNUITIES

Savings for special projects, retirement or a "rainy day" may offer a resource for increased giving. We often realize that a portion of our savings may safely be given to the work of God's Kingdom through our church.

ESTATE PLANNING

While reviewing your giving, it may also be a good time to consider if you will make a tithe or special gift to the church in your will. Estate gifts provide a powerful legacy and will help to support the mission and ministry of the church well beyond your lifetime and well beyond the scope of this capital campaign.

If you would like to add the church to your will, the church office can put you in contact with a local attorney who can, at no cost, do a simple will modification to include the church in your will.
